The EXP.22 festival was organized by the non-profit cultural association Asociación Experimentalphotofestival, registered in Barcelona, Spain, in January 2020. **Our goal is to create, promote and spread experimental photography in all its forms.** For this reason, we consider it essential to create an international community of artists who can support each other, recognize their shared equality and create collaborative projects.

Regarding the philosophical aspect, we are proud to be the first festival that has total **economic transparency** (on our website you can see where the money comes from and how it is spent) and that is based on **gender equality**, since 60% of our invited artists are women. Our festival has been built on the basis of equality and respect among all people.

With the support of the Institut d'Estudis Fotogràfics de Catalunya, the Pati Llimona Civic Center and the Nau Bostik, more than 300 international experts and photography lovers have come together with the aim of creating a common space to share, learn and debate on experimental photography in its many facets: from the creation of cameras, optics and films to the processes of printing, intervention and production of copies, exhibitions and photobooks.

With the intention of having a truly varied and complex offer and cover the diversity of aspects involved in experimental photography, the 44 most outstanding artists on the current scene were selected. The format of the workshops of this edition was different since for the

first time we had from 4, 8 and 12 hours. The limited number of participants and their lenght achieved a great connection between the participants and the artists in a practical learning context applied to a specific case. During the festival in its two spaces there were 56 faceto-face and 5 online workshops.

Merchandising

This year we published a catalog, a t-shirt and a special festival tote-bag. The catalog is a box that contains explanatory information about the festival, a theoretical book that compiles studies on experimentation, and a game, the Experimentarium, made with the images of the festival's artists and participants. With this catalog, we close a trilogy of catalogs with the container box format to look for new formats for next year.

Economy & Transparency

From non-profit our association, this year we managed a budget €36,860 from of our community and a €1,000 grant from Barcelona City Council. Based on our commitment to economic transparency, we can indicate that this year we have

spent all the money we have received. Our most important expense items have to do with artists and workers, online festival, catalog and materials for workshops. Our event has generated that the 200 participants spending more than €120,000 during their stay in the city.


















Gender Equality

This year we had 59.1% artists and 69.2% female participants. In this sense, we have shown that continuing to reproduce sexism in the visual arts is unsustainable and that we have to change things now and lead by example.






